


UPDATES TO WORK PACKAGES AND DELIVERY STRATEGY

- Previous work packages restructured to align with funding opportunities
- New work packages:
 - » Phase 1A (Construction start mid-2025)
 - » Broadway to Weidler Phase 1
 - » Remaining elements from Main Construction Package (MCP) and Early Work Packages (EWP) A, B, and C




PHASE IA CONSTRUCTION - 2025






PHASE IA – PACKAGE ELEMENTS






PHASE IA - PACKAGE ELEMENTS (CONT.)





BROADWAY WEIDLER PHASE I: FUNDED CONSTRUCTION






BROADWAY WEIDLER PHASE I – MAJOR WORK ELEMENTS

- ► Major Work Elements:
 - » Constructs new highway cover from Broadway to the south end of cover
 - » Local street elements impacted in area of highway cover construction
 - » Grading, paving, drainage, and lighting on I-5
 - » Tunnel Fire Life Safety elements
 - » Retaining walls
 - » Structure widening over the RQ Transit Center
 - » New sign bridges and ITS

THREE TYPES OF PROCUREMENT

- Best Value
 - » Combination of Price with Emphasis on Metrics
- 2. Direct Solicitation
 - » Commodity Based or Hourly Rates
- 3. Low Bid with Qualifications
 - » Combination of Qualifications with Emphasis on Price

PROPOSED BEST VALUE SCOPES

- 1. Traffic Control (\$2,000,000)
- 2. Electrical (\$340,000)
- 3. Temporary Barrier (\$700,000)
- 4. Micro-milling (\$2,900,000)
- 5. Hydro Demolition (\$1,300,000)
- 6. Roadway Barrier (\$560,000)



PROPOSED DIRECT SOLICITATION SCOPES

- 1. Concrete Pumping (\$180,000)
- 2. Noise/Vibration Monitoring (\$50,000)
- 3. Material Testing (\$350,000)
- 4. Security (\$100,000)
- 5. Sweeping (\$300,000)
- 6. Trucking (\$1,500,000)
- 7. Survey (\$150,000)



PROPOSED LOW BID WITH QUALIFICATIONS SCOPES

- 1. Rebar (\$115,000)
- 2. Micro-pile Installation (\$215,000)
- 3. Roadway Marking (\$100,000)
- 4. Steel Erection (\$150,000)
- 5. Painting (\$30,000)
- 6. Saw-Cutting (\$330,000)
- 7. Metal Railing (\$275,000)



PROPOSED SCHEDULE

- Outreach Now through February 2025
- ► Invitations to Bid Early February 2025
- ► Break Ground July 2025
- Construction July 2025 through December 2026



ANTICIPATED RESULTS

- 1. Approximate Value = \$41M
- 2. Subcontracted Value = \$21M
- 3. Anticipated DBE Participation = \$9.5M or 23%
- 4. DBE Goal per ODOT = 22%



PIPELINE PROJECTS

- Prepare, train & employ a skilled workforce
- Designed to build capacity within the labor market
 - » Address skill gaps, fostering diversity & create sustainable career pathways, particularly in underrepresented communities
 - Focuses on local economic impact
- ▶ Phase 1A pipeline project for Phase 1 & Main Package



PHASE IA ANTICIPATED IMPACTS

- Estimated labor: \$11,762,000
 - » Estimated craft hours: 92,000
 - » Estimated craft payroll: \$7,512,000
 - » Estimated management hours: 41,000
 - » Estimated management payroll: \$4,250,000
