

PHASE I A OVERVIEW



PHASE I A: 2025 CONSTRUCTION START

Construction Start: 2025

Construction Scope:

- Stormwater improvements at I-405
- Bridge preservation and seismic resiliency work at I-84
- Extension of I-5 SB merging lane from Moda Center to I-84 ramp and Morrison/OMSI exit
- Install signage for highway cover safety and construction

Benefit:

- 2025 construction of shovel-ready components
- Gets community to work: maximizes DBE participation and builds capacity
- Reduces impact of inflation
- Provides required stormwater facilities for ODOT's Portland Harbor Agreement
- Preserves I-5 bridge structures



2025 LOCAL STREET IMPACTS

- ▶ Supporting seismic upgrades to I-5 bridge structures and foundations for new intelligent signage on the south end of the project.
- ▶ Local streets with upcoming construction in Fall 2025:
 - » Oregon Street
 - » Interstate Ave
 - » I-84 OCC/Moda Ramp
- ▶ **Exact dates of closures subject to change.**



STORMWATER CONSTRUCTION – I-5 NB



- ▶ Anticipated nightly lane closures: Fall 2025
 - » Overnight closure of NB righthand lane, 10pm-5am
 - » Installing temporary construction barrier to protect work off shoulder
 - » Stormwater manhole and tie-in along shoulder

TRAFFIC IMPACT COMMUNICATIONS

Laying the groundwork for success


- ▶ Job trailer set up

PBOT received funding for the initial phase of the “Broadway Main Street” project (aka Lower Albina Streetscape Project).


This allows us to move forward with design, engineering, and engagement for the PBOT-led investments on:

- N Larrabee Ave


We are continuing to work hand-in-hand with the I5 Rose Quarter project team to ensure the projects align and investments are coordinated.




Extending the Benefits of the Highway Cap


