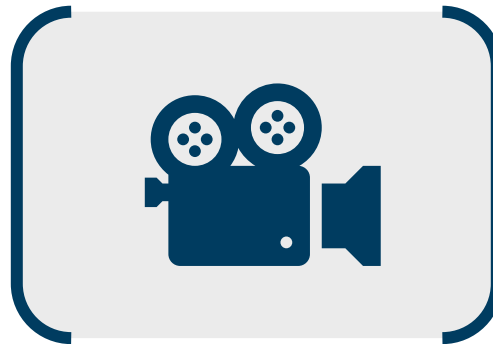

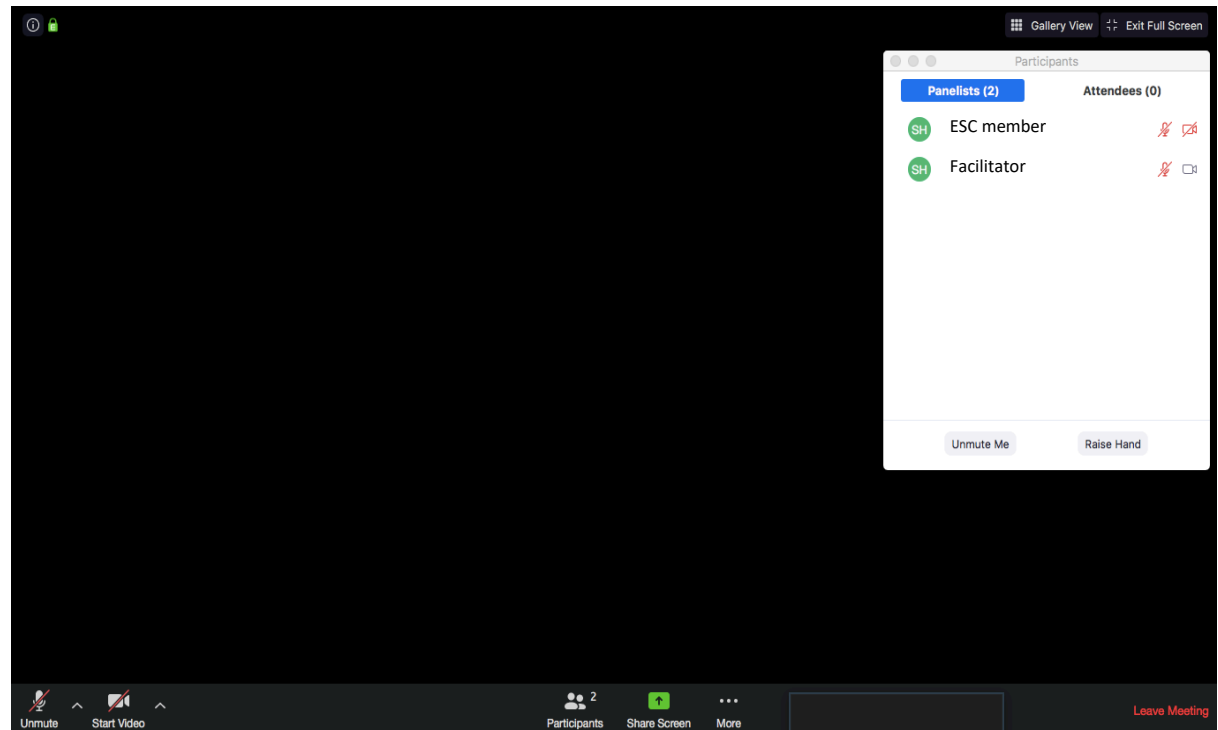

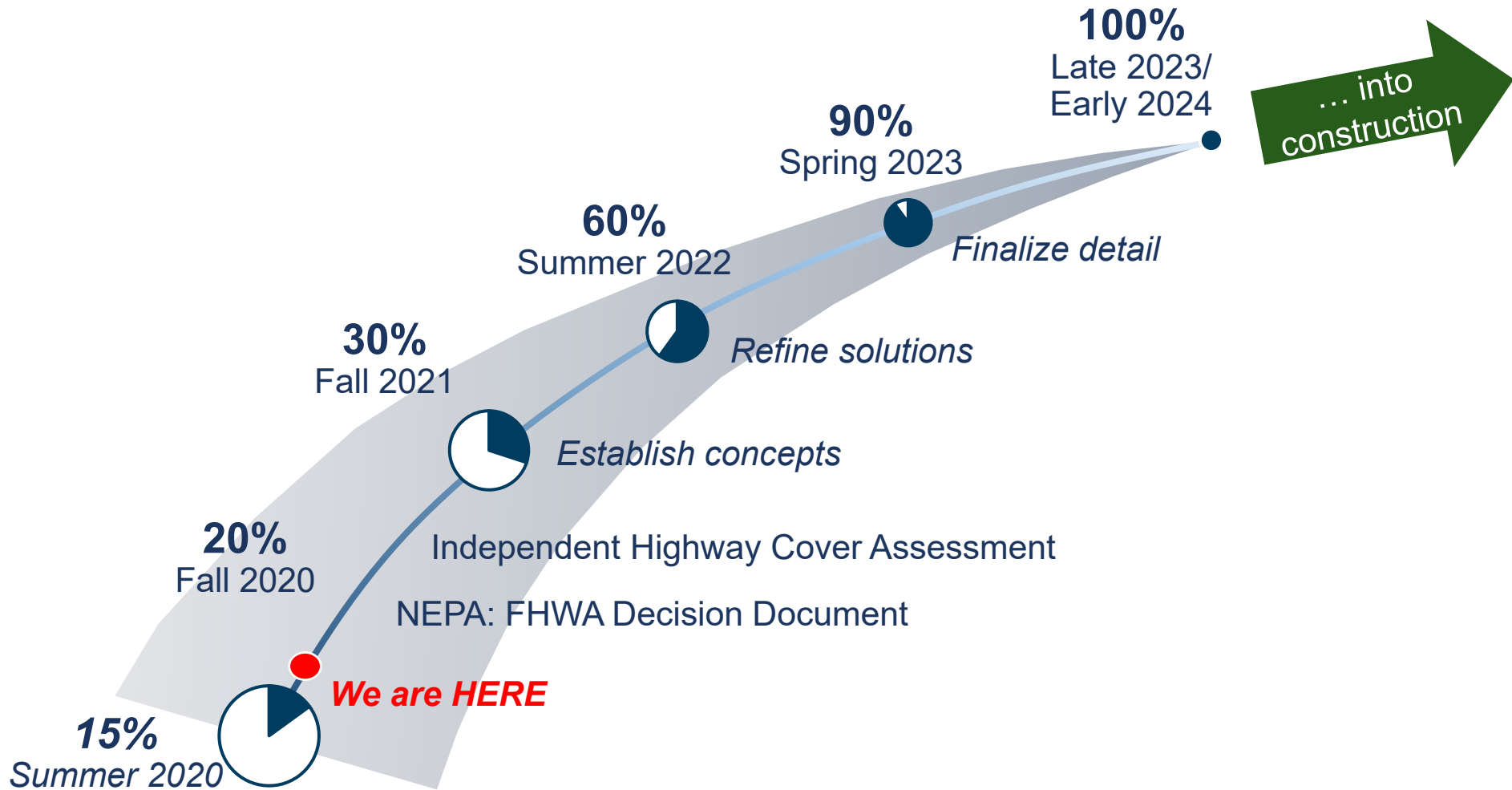


# Community Acknowledgement

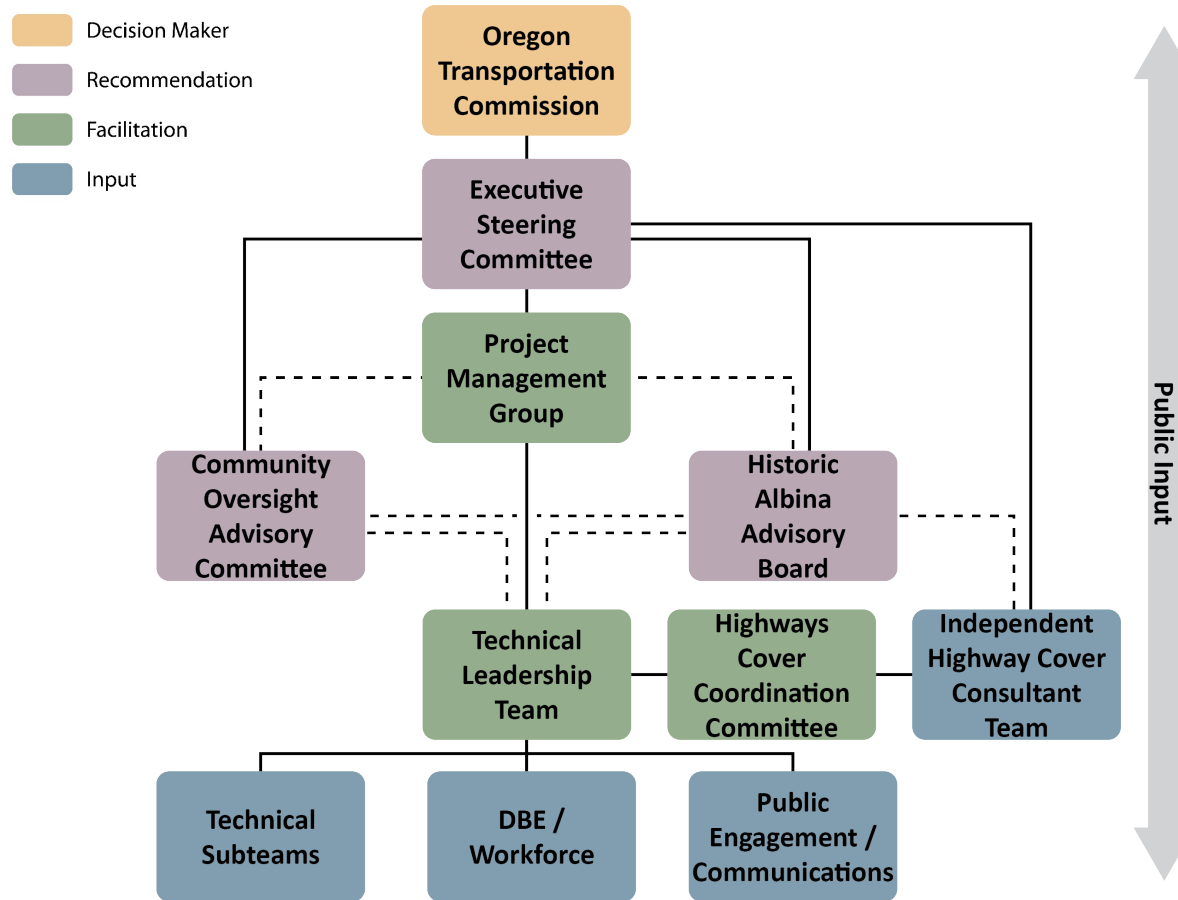
