



- ► Public Involvement Plan




BASIS OF EQUITY WORK

- Advocacy
- Oversight
- Accountability



WHAT IS THE DESIGN EQUITY FRAMEWORK?

- Establish equity practices during project design
- Formally identify historically impacted community
- Provide resources to project team to develop equity understanding
- Establish community-centered decision making and process






DESIGN EQUITY FRAMEWORK PRINCIPLES

- Community centered
- ► Active, accountable, transparent
- Required participation
- Developing students of equity
- Supported by ODOT

DESIGN EQUITY FRAMEWORK - OUTCOMES

Considerations


- » Having a plan doesn't guarantee success
- » Applying the Design Equity Framework does not achieve restorative justice

Commitments

- » Hold project team accountable to have an equity focused mindset
- » Agency and community partner to create a better project
- » Design decisions will consider equity-based perspectives and improve transparency
- » Design changes toward meeting community needs
- » Project team will improve understanding of impacted communities and equity principles
